Sun Outages Expected To Cause Interference With Cable TV Signals

AMU Cable TV customers may be seeing some interruptions in their programming over the next few weeks. These are caused by sun outages.

During the Spring and Fall Equinoxes, the sun is positioned directly in line with the ground-based satellite dish antennas used to receive Cable TV programming. The sun's energy overpowers the signals transmitted by the satellites causing programming interruptions. Sun outages last a few minutes each day during March and September.

These interruptions may cause the cable TV signal to pixalate or be blacked out. An AMU Digital Basic customer will see a message displayed on the set top converter that reads "One Moment Please" on the affected channels.
