Lighting Rebate Guidelines

1. Rebates are available only for Algonia Municipal Utilities Small Commercial, Large Commercial, or Industrial I electric customers.
2. A customer may receive up to a maximum of \$7,500 for participation in either AMU Commercial Lighting Rebate Program; i.e., the T12 to T8 Upgrade Program or the High Bay Upgrade Program. If a customer participates in both programs, the total rebate per customer for both programs shall not exceed \$7,500.
3. This program is for existing facilities using High Bay lighting fixtures that operate a minimum of 2,000 hours a year.
4. Rebate is only for upgrading existing High Bay fixtures, not adding new fixtures.
5. Rebate is not available for new construction. However, AMU reserves the right to customize a program to fit a certain customers needs for energy efficient lighting.
6. Applicants must be the customer of record for an active, non-delinquent account.
7. High Bay lighting is defined as lighting applications with ceilings of 15 ft. or higher (warehouses, gymnasiums, etc.).
8. Lighting rebates are as follows:
 - **\$200 per kW reduction in lighting load, up to \$7,500.**
 - **\$2.25 disposal fee rebate per upgraded fixture.**
 - **Total rebate for kW reduction and disposal fee cannot exceed \$7,500.**
9. Each proposed fixture upgrade must be completed in a clearly defined area of the building and indicated on the High Bay Upgrade Worksheet.
10. The High Bay Upgrade Worksheet must be completed stating the existing High Bay fixtures, as well as the proposed upgrade before a pre-evaluation can be performed.

11. Before the new lighting equipment is installed, Algona Municipal Utilities must
 - (a) perform a pre-evaluation to verify the existing lighting system and worksheet, and
 - (b) approve the customer's application.

12. The applicant has 120 days from the pre-evaluation to complete this project and submit all pertinent information. Otherwise, the rebate funds committed to this project will be released for use in another project.

13. All removed lamps and ballasts must be recycled and/or disposed of properly according to the United States Environmental Protection Agency and Iowa Department of Natural Resources regulations or the rebate may be denied.
 - Algona Municipal Utilities is requiring and will not release any rebate until each commercial customer who is participating in this program provides a Certificate of Recycling and/or Disposal. This certificate must include a Bill of Lading, as proof that hazardous materials have been disposed of properly. Magnetic ballasts contain PCB's, fluorescent lamps contain mercury, and it is a federal law that they be disposed of properly. A Certificate of Recycling and/or Disposal and Bill of Lading is provided by the Resource Recovery Facility who transports the items from the customer's facility

14. Required Information:
 - Completed Commercial Lighting Rebate Application.
 - Completed High Bay Upgrade Worksheet.
 - Copies of all receipts and invoices of installed equipment.
 - Copies of all work orders.
 - Certificate of Recycling and Disposal with a Bill of Lading.

15. Rebates may be denied if all stated information has not been submitted or is incomplete.

16. A post-evaluation will be performed by a Algona Municipal Utilities energy auditor at the installation site, and if such site does not have the qualifying equipment installed, the rebate may be denied.

17. This rebate program may be canceled at any time without notice.

18. The rebate will be processed within 3 to 5 weeks from the post-evaluation date and applied to the applicant's utility bill or a check can be issued as directed by the applicant.
